### Changes to Fellside's Patterns of Provision from September 2017

From September 2017, we are looking to change our provision considerably in order to give parents greater flexibility. Options are detailed below. We would like to know now what your preference would be as we are keen to tailor our provision as closely as possible to parental demand. **Please note that this provision is subject to confirmation and availability.**

Oversubscription criteria will apply in the event that the number of applicants exceeds places available.

- 5 morning sessions (8.30am – 11.30am)
- 5 afternoon sessions (12.30pm – 3.30pm)
- 2 ½ days (Mondays and Tuesdays 8.30-3.30pm and Wednesdays 8.30am-11.30pm)
- 2 ½ days (Wednesdays 12.30 to 3.30pm and Thursdays and Fridays 8.30am to 3.30pm)
- 5 full days (Monday to Friday 8.30am to 3.30pm)\*

\*Eligibility to a full time (30 hours) nursery place is subject to meeting specific criteria to be introduced by the government from September 2017. Please refer to the leaflet enclosed for further information about this criteria.

Please note that full-time days will include a lunch break. It is likely that parents will be able to choose between providing a packed lunch for their child, or request a school lunch.

#### **Our Current Admissions Policy**

Parents may wish to refer to our Admissions Policy for details on how we allocate places. Please note, however, our policy for 2017/2018 admission is currently being remodelled to reflect the planned changes to our provision and the introduction of the increased number of free child care hours from 15 to 30 (for eligible parents) from September 2017.

Our *current* model of provision offers x2 options to parents: x5 mornings from 8.30am to 11.30am *or* x5 afternoons from 12.30pm to 3.30pm and our interim Admissions Policy has been written to reflect this.

Obtaining a place in our school nursery class does not guarantee your child a place in our school for entry to Reception class.
